Petersburg, VA – Pamplin Historical Park and The National Museum of the Civil War Soldier will be open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during the summer season beginning Saturday, June 12. Guided tours, costumed interpretation and all museums will be offered to visitors daily.

The Park will host Teacher Institutes, History Day Camps, overnight Civil War Adventure Camps, and a tour to West Virginia in September. The symposium in October is the first in a series commemorating the Sesquicentennial of the Civil War and focuses on the presidential election of 1860.
